

DIY dish soap







what you will need

- 7 -10g of curd soap (7g for Sonett soap, 10g for Patounis soap)
- 250ml water
- 6g baking soda
- 4g washing soda
- 5g coco glycoside (alternative: organic dishwashing liquid)
- 7 drops of essential lemon or orange oil

utensils

- 300ml bottle with pump attachment (old soap bottle)
- scale
- measuring cup
- small pot
- whisk
- funnel
- 2 glass bowls







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let's start cooking :)

- turn the soap bar into soap flakes using the grater
- bring the soap flakes to a boil in a saucepan with 250ml of water, stirring constantly, until all the soap flakes have dissolved
- remove from the oven and allow to cool briefly
- meanwhile, weigh the baking soda and washing soda in a glass bowl and mix into the warm liquid until everything is well mixed. The mixture should thicken a little
- add the coco glycoside/washing liquid and the essential oils and stir well
- pour the finished washing liquid into the bottle and allow to thicken overnight
